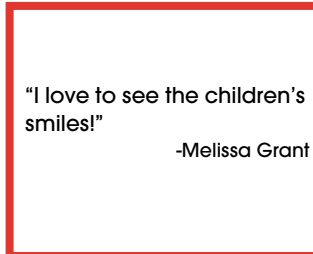

museum docent - guide

Volunteers provide supervision and guidance to guests of the museum as they experience the galleries.

gallery crew

Volunteers assist in preventative maintenance procedures that preserve the life of the exhibits and assure a clean and safe experience for children.



special event volunteer

Volunteers represent and assist the MMCM at special events that further the mission and purpose of the organization. The events may be held on site or at any outside location in and around the Great Lakes Bay Region.
